## **OBSOLETE POLICY DIRECTIVE ABORIGINAL DEATHS IN CUSTODY - FAMILY COUNSELLING PROTOCOL**

### **PURPOSE**

To notify the Health System that PD2005\_486 Aboriginal Deaths in Custody - Family Counselling Protocol is no longer current.

### **KEY INFORMATION**

The above named policy directive has been reviewed by the Centre for Aboriginal Health and is deemed obsolete. The status of this policy directive has been changed to obsolete and now appears in the 'Archive' section of the Policy Distribution System.

Consultations undertaken as part of the policy review process considered that Aboriginal deaths in custody have decreased significantly since the Royal Commission into Aboriginal Deaths in Custody, and that the policy was too general to be useful and refers to services no longer in existence.

For these reasons, the Policy Directive has been made obsolete.
