- **Summary** The purpose of this Information Bulletin is to advise the NSW Health System of the training requirements (internal and external courses) and administrative processes for personnel involved in Emergency Management (Prevention, Preparation, Response and Recovery). The Framework details the training requirements for all categories of personnel.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT EDUCATION FRAMEWORK

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Information Bulletin is to advise the NSW Health System of the training requirements (internal and external courses) and administrative processes for personnel involved in emergency management (Prevention, Preparation, Response and Recovery).

The Framework details the training requirements for all categories of personnel.

KEY INFORMATION

Training and education of personnel working in emergency management is a requirement as detailed in NSW Health Services Functional Area Supporting Plan (NSW HEALTHPLAN) – PD2014_012 and Emergency Management Arrangements for NSW Health PD 2012_067. NSW HEALTHPLAN is a supporting plan of the NSW State Emergency Management Plan.¹

The framework is divided into:

- Expected, Role Dependent and Recommended training
- Prevention, Preparation, Response and Recovery
- Categories of staff identified as having a role in an emergency (key emergency health service position holders and others).

The administrative processes informs personnel of payment responsibilities and requirements for approval.

As identified in NSW Health Services Functional Area Supporting Plan (NSW HEALTHPLAN)² and Emergency Management Arrangements for NSW Health³:

- 1. NSW Health agencies are responsible for:
 - Implementing emergency management education programs that enhance the knowledge and skills of their staff
 - Ensuring there are adequate numbers of trained personnel to respond to emergencies
 - Informing the targeted staff of the requirement to complete the training dependent on their individual roles or responsibilities.
- 2. NSW Health Emergency Management Unit (HEMU) is responsible for:
 - Developing and endorsing the Emergency Management Education Framework (as attached)

- Ensuring all courses detailed in the framework meet the requirements to address State and Commonwealth directions
- Reviewing the content of each module annually
- Coordinating and/or delivering specific external education courses.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Definitions

<u>Expected</u> means training that is essential for personnel to complete when requesting to work in emergency management.

<u>Recommended</u> means training should be undertaken to maintain best practice within the professional development environment.

<u>Role dependent</u> means training may be required dependent of the duties within the role you are appointed e.g. public health may be required within some LHDs and not others. LHD to risk assess and decide.

<u>NSW Health Agencies</u> means Ministry of Health, all Local Health Districts, Specialty Networks, NSW Ambulance, NSW Health Pathology, Public Health System Support Division and Affiliated Health Organisations.

Education and Training Details

Courses offered externally to NSW Health

As per the Framework, the following courses are provided/managed by external organisations. Whilst some of the trainers are employed by NSW Health, the course content is subject to the requirements provided by the external organisations. The application process to enrol in these courses is detailed in Table 1. Detailed descriptions of the courses and requirements are located on the relevant websites.

HEMU as the agent is responsible for coordinating and/or delivering health specific education courses for Advanced Life Support Group (ALSG - UK), NCCTRC and Emergo Train System Australia & New Zealand.

Courses offered by NSW Department of Justice, Office of Emergency Management are for emergency management workers and are face-to-face and online.

Courses offered internally by NSW Health

The courses offered by NSW Health are through the My Health Learning portal at <u>http://myhealthlearning.health.nsw.gov.au</u>. These consist of both on-line and face-to-face. Enrolment in face-to-face courses offered will require approval by the staff member's manager.

Financial and Administrative Arrangements

The cost of external courses is made up of registration, travel and accommodation. As detailed in Table 1 these can be funded by either the participant, the employer, the training provider, or organisation. With respect to the participant, the employer may choose to support the participant. The participant should negotiate the financial support at the time of the application.

On successful application HEMU is responsible to inform the applicants of the funding arrangements detailed in Table 1.

The costs (including travel and accommodation) associated with face-to-face courses listed with My Health Learning are to be covered by the relevant NSW Health Agency employer.
