Increased Rates of Pay and Allowances for Operational Ambulance Managers

PURPOSE

The Information Bulletin advises of increases in rates of pay and allowances, from the first full pay period on or after 1 July 2023, for staff covered by the Operational Ambulance Managers (State) Award 2023.

KEY INFORMATION

The <u>Operational Ambulance Manger (State) Award 2023</u> was made by Chief Commissioner Constant of the NSW Industrial Relations Commission. The Award provides a 4.0 per cent increase to wages and wage related allowances.

Increase in Climatic, Isolation and Laundry Allowances

Laundry, climatic and isolation allowances have been increased by 7.0 per cent from the first pay period to commence on or after 1 July 2023 in line with the percentage change in the All-Groups CPI Weighted Average for the eight Capital Cities March Quarter 2022 to March Quarter 2023.
